## **About the Donor**

The Auburn Area Kiwanis Club and Kiwanis Indiana Foundation, Inc. sponsor these two scholarships.

## **Eligibility Criteria**

Both scholarships are awarded to graduating seniors from any **DeKalb County high school or Hamilton High School (DeKalb County residents only)** pursuing **any field of study**.

Applicants must also:

- Have a good academic record, SAT scores, and college prep
- Participated in extra-curricular activities and community service
- Have a financial need
- Be a resident of DeKalb County, Indiana
- Enroll, or intends to enroll, full-time at an accredited post-secondary educational institution the fall semester after graduation.

The Auburn Area Kiwanis scholarship is a renewable award totaling \$2,000 (\$500/school year for four years). Continuation of the award will be dependent upon a successful and satisfactory (C average or above) completion of the year. The recipient must attend school for four (4) years to receive the full \$2,000.00.

The Kiwanis Indiana Foundation scholarship is a one-time award of \$1,000. Applicant must attend an accredited post-secondary educational institution **within the state of Indiana**.
