## **Eligibility Criteria**

This scholarship is a renewable award of \$1,000 per year (payable at \$500/semester for up to four (4) years) to a graduating senior from **Garrett High School** (DeKalb County, Indiana) pursuing **any field of study** (primarily a four-year degree program). Financial need may be a consideration.

Applicant must also:

- Have a grade point average of 5.0 ( C ) or higher
- Be a United States citizen

Student must send a copy of grades and maintain at least 15 credit hours of C or better grades per semester to continue award.

- Completed Application
- Essay
- High School Transcript (including SAT scores and rank in class)

## **Interview**

An interview may be part of the selection process.
