Eligibility Criteria

This scholarship is a one-time award to a graduating senior from **DeKalb High School** (DeKalb County, Indiana) studying **art, music, dance or drama**. Children of Tri Kappa members are not eligible for this award.

Applicant must also:

- Have a strong GPA in chosen subject (7.0 GPA overall and 8.0 GPA in the arts)
- Be a resident of DeKalb County, Indiana
- Be highly motivated to attend and succeed in college
- Enroll, or intends to enroll, full-time in a post-secondary educational institution

Required Forms (Submit in the order listed)

- Scholarship Cover Page
- Completed Application
- Essay
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation (Use Recommendation Form) from teachers
- High School Transcript

Review

A volunteer committee will review the material submitted.

Interview

An interview may be a part of the selection process.

Deadline to Apply

Submit all documents to the High School Guidance Office by **February 26, 2010**.
