About the Donor

Eligibility Criteria

This scholarship is a one-time award for a **current full-time college student** pursuing a four-year degree in a **healthcare or medical field**. Eligible applicants must have **completed their freshman year of college** and have a permanent residence within DeKalb County (Indiana). Financial need will be a strong factor in the selection process.

Even though this is a non-renewable award, past recipients may re-apply each year.

Required Forms (Submit in the order listed)

- Scholarship Cover Page
 - Completed Application
 - Essay
 - Financial Assistance Statement
 - Two (2) Letters of Recommendations (Use Letter of Recommendation Form for College Students)
 - 1 – Personal Recommendation (Non-related)
 - 1 – Professional Recommendation (Select from the following options)
 - Civic Organization co-member (officer, etc.)
 - Volunteer Organization co-member (supervisor, etc.), or
 - Previous employer/business associate
 - College Transcript
- Attach an OFFICIAL copy of your college transcript to your application or have it sent electronically to dbrown@dekalbfoundation.org by your college.

Scholarship Payment

Scholarships administered by the DeKalb County Community Foundation can be applied towards tuition, books, and required fees. It may not be used for room and board expenses.

Scholarship funds are sent directly to the specified institution named on the application.
